

## Hope Chapel: Wedding Venue

The venue for a wedding ceremony will remain a life-long memory for couples and for their families and friends – and will be recorded in photographs for posterity. A municipal building or branded hotel chain is unlikely to have the ambience and character of a place like Hope Chapel, which is in the middle of funky Hebden Bridge set among the lovely Pennine hills.



Hope Chapel has been the subject of a £1m repair and restoration programme over recent years. With Corinthian pilasters decorating the exterior of the building and glowing woodwork inside, it is difficult not to be impressed by this listed chapel and landmark building that has been a place of worship – and weddings – for many people in and around Calderdale since it was opened in 1857.

- Facilities for wedding breakfast or drinks reception
- Registered and welcoming venue for same sex marriages
